
Subj: LETTER OF APPOINTMENT AS MARINE CORPS BASE, CAMP PENDLETON'S
REPRESENTATIVE TO THE SAN ONOFRE NUCLEAR GENERATING STATION COMMUNITY
ENGAGEMENT PANEL

1. You are hereby appointed as the assigned Command representative of Marine Corps Installations West-Marine Corps Base, Camp Pendleton to serve on the San Onofre Nuclear Generating Station (SONGS) Community Engagement Panel (CEP), established by Southern California Edison and the other co-owners of SONGS. The CEP has been established for the purpose of fostering open dialogue on issues of community interest associated with the planned decommissioning of the SONGS facility.

2. As the assigned Command representative, your role is to serve as the Base Commander's direct representative to the CEP and be an unofficial ambassador to the other member agencies who serve on this Panel. Your duties include, but are not limited to, attending regular meetings of the CEP and other CEP-related activities as outlined in the SONGS Decommissioning CEP Charter. While your primary focus may be on protecting the interests of MCB CamPen, the Marine Corps, the Department of the Navy, and the active duty service members and families assigned to this Installation, you are to also serve as an envoy to other participating organizations on the CEP where MCB CamPen issues may arise.

3. I encourage you to become familiar with the SONGS decommissioning plan and any special interests related to the decommissioning process which may have an impact on the operational mission of this Installation. If an issue arises that requires action on the part of the Command, please bring it to the attention of the appropriate commander, staff section, or the Chief of Staff for prompt resolution.

4. I will notify the Chairman of the CEP that you are the primary point of contact for issues of mutual interest between the owners of SONGS and this Command. I appreciate your interest in volunteering to take on this additional responsibility.
