- New Interim Consolidated Storage Act of 2015
 - Sponsored by Congressman Mike Conaway (R-TX)
 - Co-sponsored by Darrell Issa (R-CA)
 - Amends Nuclear Waste Policy Act, allowing DOE to:
 - Take title to used fuel
 - Contract with private companies to store it
 - Progress moving beyond a Yucca-only position
