> of NRC's recent License Exemption approvals .

> The technical reports contain evidence that does not support exemption approvals in areas of high seismic risk (in western U.S.). At San Onofre, there are multiple unique and site specific hazards (seismic, tsunami,

> fire) that are not shared with the other reactor locations where Licensees

> had exemption approvals processed by NRC. At San Onofre, public

> stakeholders examined SCE's recently released technical reports, and found that on multiple risk assessment levels, Consultant reports indicate more discretion and analysis should have been applied.
